Directions to Mid-Pacific Country Club (Be sure to save these to take with you.)

Drive into Kailua on the Pali Highway, which becomes Kailua Road. Stay on Kailua Road when it makes a right turn at the big intersection with the banyan tree. Continue on Kailua Road when it makes a left turn at the light. Continue on Kailua Road until you angle to the right, then continue across the bridge, past Buzz's Steak House. You are now on Kawailoa Road. continue until you reach a Stop sign. Turn left on Alala Road. Continue on Alala Road which become Mokulua Drive. Turn right on Kaelepu Drive. Drive to the country club.
